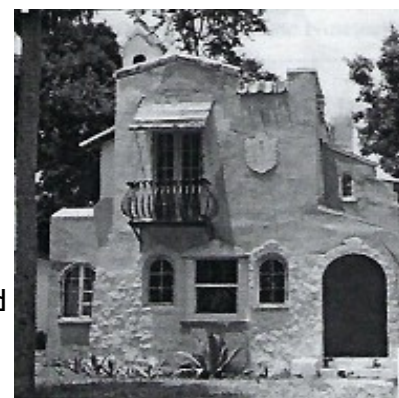
Holly Hill 58th Annual Christmas Parade

Historic Burleigh Home Saved From Demolition

Society member Gilles Blais spoke up when the city manager asked the city commission to issue a demolition permit for the Burleigh house at 430 Burleigh Avenue. The Mediterranean Revival Style house was built by Mr. Burleigh as his home in 1925. He was also the builder for many of the homes in the area. This home was owned by an out of state owner. It had fallen into great disrepair, especially after the recent hurricanes. Mr. Blais convinced the commission to try to contact the owners again after sharing the historic value of the property. The home now has a new owner who is restoring it to its former glory, including the unique sundial medallion on its façade. A similar home next door was honored with an Historic Landmark Plaque by the Society in 2005.
