Holly Hill Museum will be affected by the construction of the new Pictona Pickle Ball courts in Hollyland Park. The facility is scheduled to open in 2020. Our parking is limited, but available at the same entrance by the Museum on the marked grass & slab. Unfortunately this will affect attendance and the Society will not be able to host programs at the Museum due to the limited parking. The Tour of Homes will be less affected. The Museum was closed several days for utility work.

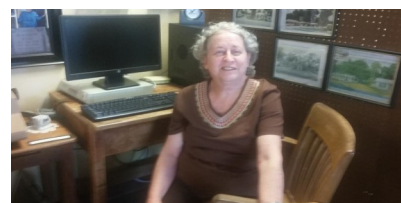


Museum Updates Website
