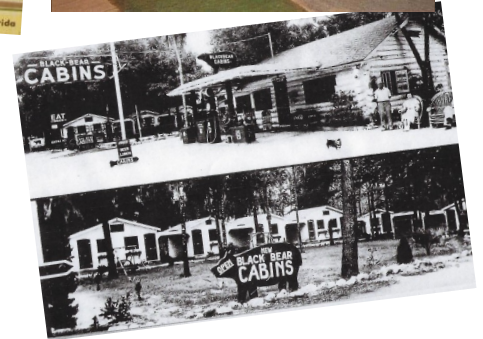
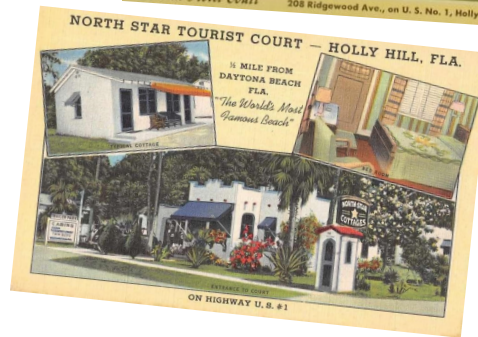

The Museum is gathering information and photos about its many Motor Courts and camps dating back to the 1920's. If you have any memories or pictures to share please contact the museum.

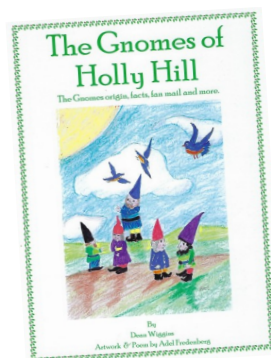


Gnome Collectibles Available
